IR/PS Students in Demand

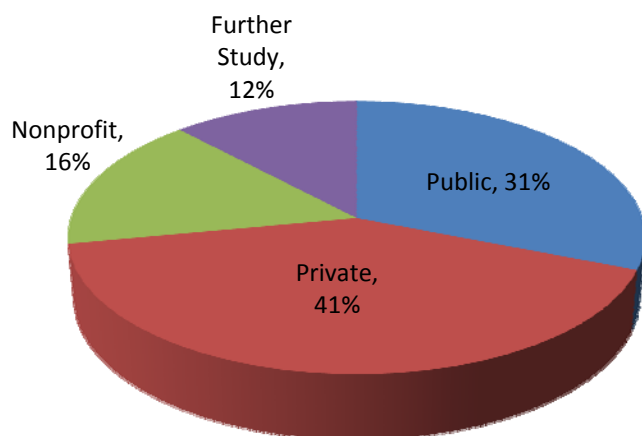

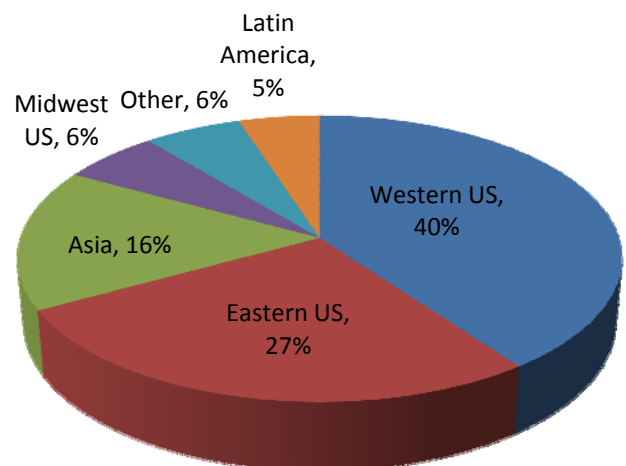
Class of 2008 Employment:

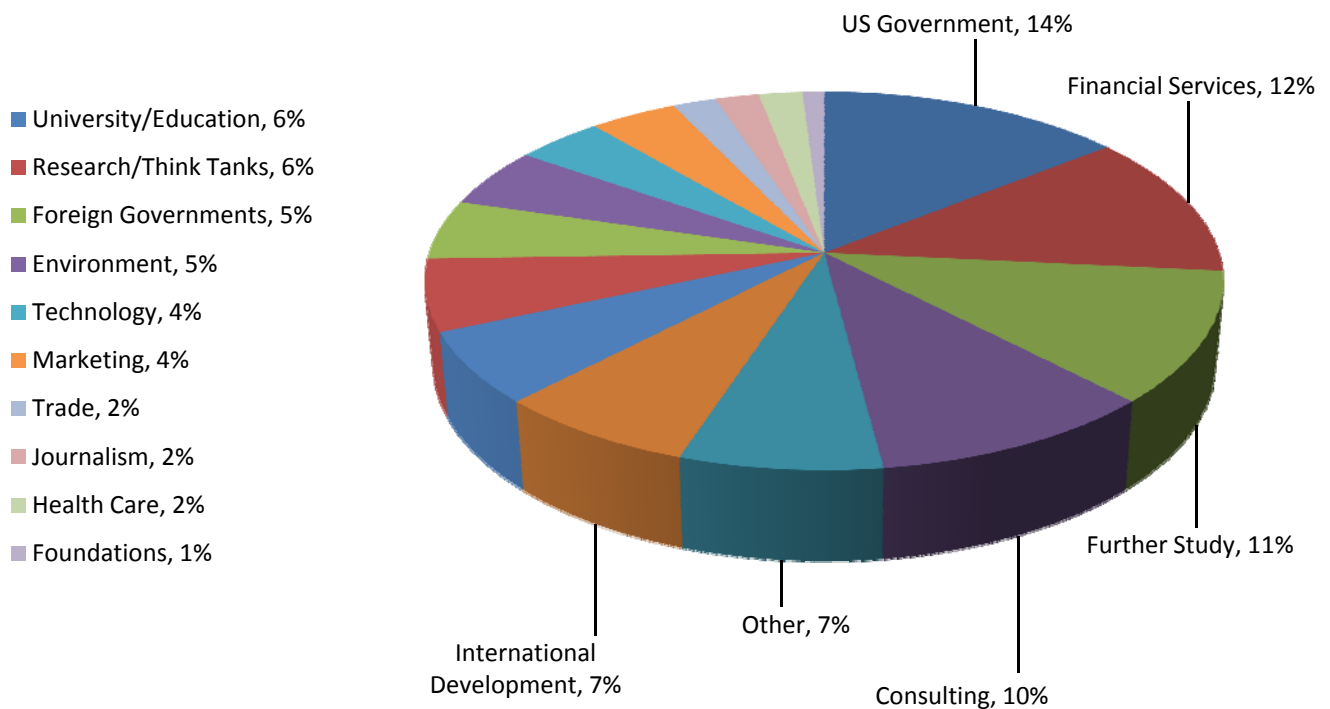
Employment by Sector
